Eligibility to participate

Who can participate?

- Studierende and employees of KIT.
- Both students and employees who have participated in an international exchange program, internship abroad or research abroad in the last 2 years may participate.

2. Conditions of participation

Image resolution and format:

Photos must be submitted in high resolution to ensure good print quality.

150 dpi is the minimum accepted for printing, 300 dpi is best. Pixel size:
The higher this number is, the sharper the image will be. A good basis is
Full HD resolution with 1,920 x 1,080 pixels (1080p). -> Taking pictures with your cell phone o Accepted file formats: JPEG, PNG.

Image content:

- The pictures should reflect authentic and positive experiences during the stay abroad.
- Motifs can be landscapes, cultural events, culinary cuisine, everyday scenes, new acquaintances, or even self-portraits in front of well-known sights.
- The images must not contain any offensive, discriminatory or copyrighted content.

Legal information:

- Participants must confirm that they own the rights to the photos submitted and that all persons depicted (if recognizable) have consented to publication.
- o Participants must agree to the privacy policy.
- The KIT (INTL) receives the right to use the submitted photos as part of the exhibition and for the promotion of the International Days.

3. Award

 Vouchers for photo prints and travel bookshop, among other things.
